Called to Order and Pledge of Allegiance led by Bill Bailey, LHA president, @ 9:15 am.

Chuck Allen made a motion to waive the reading of the 2016 minutes. It was seconded by Tim Stachnick. All in favor.

This meeting proceeded through a power point presentation which is an attachment to these minutes.

Hadlock Park District Budget Presentation given by Richie Moore, Fort Ann Town Supervisor. He presented data from 2012 to 2017 on the budget, fund balance, levy, and %change. A question and answer period followed.

Kyle Belokopitsky made a motion to accept amendments to article III Election of Officers and Members, and Article V Dues of the bylaws. It was seconded by Cathy Matier. All in favor.(The notice of these changes were mailed in late May to everyone in the park district.)

Kathy Stachnick , LHA treasurer, presented the past year's income and expenses.

Committee Reports:

Membership-A membership mailing was done in late May to the 270 property owners in the park district. Please remind your neighbors to join the association. Paypal is available on our website.

Sal Ricciardone spoke of CSLAP , Citizens Statewide Lake Assessment Program. We were not part of this last year due to a routine rollout from the program but we are back in for 2017. Sal has already taken two readings and both show promising turbidity readings. The association in conjunction with the Darrin freshwater Institute will be conducting further water quality samples checking for ecoli and phosphorus. Bob Bishop and Tim Stachnick are helping.

Joe Losynzski , lake manager, gave a presentation covering this past year's program . The harvester has been overhauled and is in good working order. There is a person being trained to run the harvester in future years. AIM, Adirondack Invasive Management, has been contracted with to do 6 weeks of hand harvesting which is currently the favored method. Much stress is being put on the picking up of fragments found floating in the lake. It is the major source of spread. When you have accumulated any piles, call Joe. Joe is also looking for volunteers to be lake monitors and shoreline management team members.
