Board Meeting  
Sept. 29, 2018 9 am WFA firehouse

Present: Bill Bailey, Kathy Stachnick, Tim Stachnick, Lorraine Connor, Cathy Matier, Bob Bishop, Penny Gould, and Joe Loszynski(guest).

Meetings coming-Bill: Bill will attend the ALA president's meeting in Keene on October 24 as well as the Champlain Watershed Basin meeting on Nov. 8.

Bags for spring drop-Bill: JT is continuing his research to locate what we need.

Fish Survey-Tim: Weather permitting, Margaret Murphy and SUNY Cobleskill will arrive Wednesday, October 3 at the beach with the electroshocking happening at dusk. We budgeted \$5500 and the actual cost is \$3914.

Apparel-Bob: All t-shirts were sold at lake social in August. There was \$110 in profit to be donated to the Town for youth programs. Bob will arrange for another sale to occur in November.  
To do-Kathy will contact the Town and arrange for the delivery of the donation.

Picnic-Tim and Cathy: Kyle did a great job organizing this social. It was attended by a mix of people at an approximate cost of \$200. Dan Ladd was terrific. Cathy has many leftover hotdogs for the fishing derby. It is hoped that it will be repeated next year.  
Penny motioned that in the future, we pay the \$150 that Cathy pays Dan. Tim seconded. Cathy abstained from the vote. All others in favor.

Drawdown-Bill: When is the date? We will put it up on the road sign.  
To do-Joe will find out and let us know. (It is Oct. 15)

Buoys-Tim and Cathy: If the weather is good next weekend, they will be taken. Bill and Penny have a shoreline tree being cut this winter so the buoys need a safer winter storage.

Budget, Harvester and Way Finder-Joe: Joe stated that solid science is behind suction harvesting. It does not support mowing the lawn for invasives. He will propose the purchase of a suction harvest boat and the hiring of a dive team for this year's budget, and the continued use of our present harvester. Joe has all of the specs for the purchase of a new harvester for Kyle to use if it appears that there is legislative monies available. Mapping/Way Finder program will start on Wednesday, October 3 with Erin from APIPP. Joe, Hannah, Bill, and Penny will assist and learn how to do this. It will create a grid with 157 waypoints that will map our weed beds by type. It will be an annual project and will be invaluable as a resource.

Motion made by Bill and seconded by Cathy to reimburse Joe for the cost of the \$88 scope and \$200 tablet needed for the mapping if the Town does not cover them. All in favor.

To do: A future meeting discussion needs to be had on how to create a greater voice for the lake. Bill will call Joe to tell him that LHA will reimburse.

Membership-Penny: We have 94 members. Using the denominator of 262 tax district property owners, 36% are LHA members. We reach 90% (85) of our members with email. There are another 74 non 2018 members that we have emails for. We reach 61% of all of the tax district owners through email.

Domain-Cathy: The domain/website has been renewed for 5 years.
